

## HOME GROUP QUESTIONS FROM SERMON 5<sup>th</sup> May 2024

GOD HAS SPOKEN... Psalm 19 (all)

<u>Ice breaker</u>: describe the moment you enjoyed either a wonderful sunset or dawn sunrise, perhaps on holiday or at a special moment in your life.

**1. THROUGH CREATION** 

The heavens declare the glory of God, and the sky above proclaims his handiwork. 2 Day to day pours out speech,

- and night to night reveals knowledge.
- 3 There is no speech, nor are there words, whose voice is not heard.
- 4 Their voice goes out through all the earth, and their words to the end of the world.
- In them he has set a tent for the sun,
- 5 which comes out like a bridegroom leaving his chamber, and, like a strong man, runs its course with joy.
- 6 Its rising is from the end of the heavens, and its circuit to the end of them, and there is nothing hidden from its heat.

- 7 The law of the Lord is perfect,
  - reviving the soul;

the testimony of the Lord is sure,

- making wise the simple;
- 8 the precepts of the Lord are right, rejoicing the heart;
- the commandment of the Lord is pure, enlightening the eyes;
- 9 the fear of the Lord is clean,
- enduring for ever;
- the rules of the Lord are true,
- and righteous altogether.
- 10 More to be desired are they than gold,
- even much fine gold;
- sweeter also than honey
- and drippings of the honeycomb.
- 11 Moreover, by them is your servant warned; in keeping them there is great reward.
